- ...provides two months of personal and hygiene items for someone living in a homeless shelter.
- ...provides a 15-day supply of food for a family of four.
- ...pays for Girl Scout USA membership for four local low-income girls, enabling them to take advantage of scouting for one year.
- ...provides a week of supervised homework assistance for seven homeless children.
- ...pays for one low-income child's breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack for two and half weeks at a local, accredited preschool.
- ...provides two book bags filled with new school supplies for two low-income children.
- ...provides dental sealants for a low-income child.
- ...pays for three hours of home assistant services (light cleaning, meal preparation, etc.) for a low-income, home-bound senior.
- ...provides two group therapy sessions for a low-income child dealing with a trauma such as violence or abuse.

A One-Time Gift of...

- ...\$15 provides an individual with a voucher to a clothing thrift store.
- ...\$24 will pay for interpretation services for Burmese residents who need help understanding medical bills and medical information.
- ...\$45 provides one week of quality after-school care for a low-income child.
- ...\$60 provides two winter coats for two low-income children.
